

Prospectus for "Confucius Institute Scholarship" Program at Lanzhou University

I. Major and Category

- 1. One-year Chinese language studying program
- 2. Master of teaching Chinese to speakers of other languages (MTCSOL) program

II. Details of studies

Full-time courses taught in Chinese

- 1. One-year Chinese language studying program
- 2. 2 years for MTCSOL

III. Details of the Scholarships

- 1. Exempt from registration fee, tuition fee
- Monthly allowance are at the following rates (CNY Yuan per month) One-year studying student: CNY1,400 MTCSOL: CNY1,700 One-off settlement subsidy, CNY 1,500
- 3. Students will be exempted from part of the fee for outpatient medical services generated in hospitals affiliated to Lanzhou University or the hospitals appointed by Lanzhou University. International students need to pay a certain percentage of those expenses in accordance with Lanzhou University's relevant regulations.
- 4. Lanzhou University will provide accommodation on campus. The university will not be responsible for any expenses incurred by family members or visitors.

IV. Eligibility

1.Applicants must be foreign nationals, and in good health, who must hold valid passports and will observe all the laws of China as well as the rules and regulations of Lanzhou University.

2. Applicants for one year Chinese studying program are required to have a basic Chinese knowledge or Chinese language level, and under the age of 55.



3. Applicants for MTCSOL program are required to have a diploma comparable to a Chinese bachelor degree, and between the age of 18-45.

V. Application documents

1. International Students Application Form for Lanzhou University printed in Chinese or in English (downloadable from http://sice.lzu.edu.cn).

2. Two copies of Application Form for Confucius Institute Scholarship. Students should register at <u>http://cis.chinese.cn</u>, and fill in the application form online. Once registered, your account name and password will be sent to your e-mail address. Please print and sign the application form once completed.

3. Highest diploma and transcripts (notarized Chinese or English translation).

Proof of student status or current employer's introductory letter.

4. Personal statements. The statement should be no less than 200 words, printed in either Chinese or English and signed by the applicant.

5. Photocopy of Foreigner Physical Examination Form filled in English. Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician, the official stamp of the hospital or a sealed photograph of the applicant are invalid.

6. Three photocopies of the passport page and 3 passport-size photos;

7. For MTCSOL, applicants should provide HSK transcript and 2 recommendation letters from different professors.

Notes:

All forms should be printed double-sided with real signature at the bottom.

Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with translations in Chinese or English.

Applicants must send all the required documents by post (or express mail). Incomplete or invalid documents will be rejected.

The application materials will not be returned regardless of the result of application.

VI. Application Deadline

Applications should be sent before April 15th, 2010. Students admitted please follow registration date on the admission notice.
